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
BEEHIVE SMALL QUILT FABRIC GUIDE


Use this guide to make a quilt that looks like my sample.

You will need one fat eighth (9" x 21") of each Stripe Fabric. You will need one fat quarter (18" x 21" each) of each Wing Fabric. If you have an older pattern that doesn't already include them, refer to the diagrams below to cut these fabrics.

All fabrics were manufactured by Robert Kaufman and include Kona Solids, Essex Yarn-Dyed (YD) linen, and my Paintbox prints and Kitchen Window Wovens. Background fabric is Essex Yarn-Dyed Dusty Blue. Dark Solid Detail Fabric is Kona Espresso. Refer to your pattern back for yardages.

Each pair of Body and Wing fabrics will be used to make a set of 5 blocks. In this guide, I've labeled each group with a letter code, A - E. If you'd like to duplicate the block placement in my quilt, you can refer to the quilt diagram below.
